

The RV CLEAN “IN’S & OUT’S” OF A DUMP STATION



Avoid Nasty Waste Water Spills

Be sure to keep your gate valve seals are in good condition. These valves keep your holding tank waste sealed tight until you can connect a hose and dump.

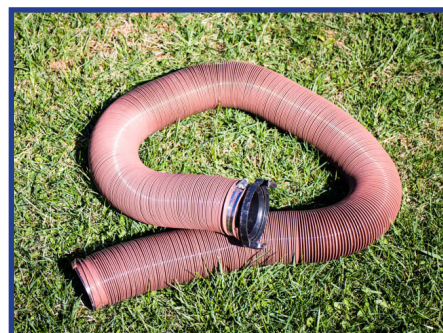


Keep It Sanitary

Be sure to use the proper RV sewer hose that has a tight fitting connection. Used disposable gloves, wipes, and anti-bacterial hand sanitizer. Wipe down the contaminated surfaces before you leave the area.

Decrease The Risk of Contaminating Your Fresh Water Hose

Be sure to be close enough for the hose reach the potable water spigot. Decontaminate the spigot with bleach wipes before connecting your hose .



Reduce The Chance of Spreading Feces And Urine Pathogens

Dump your RV black water first and be sure that you dump only when it is 2/3 full or more. With a cleaner sewer hose, you can view the contents easily. Then dump your gray water allowing bathroom and kitchen water to flow and rise out the sewer hose.

Be Swift and Make a Clean Getaway

Be curious to your fellow RV'er and get rid of your holding tank as swiftly and cleanly as possible. Remove your garbage, wipes, gloves and dispose properly. If you need to back-flush your tanks, use that for a full-hookup campsite.
